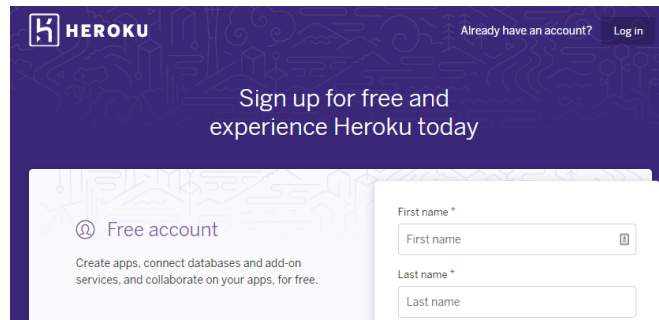
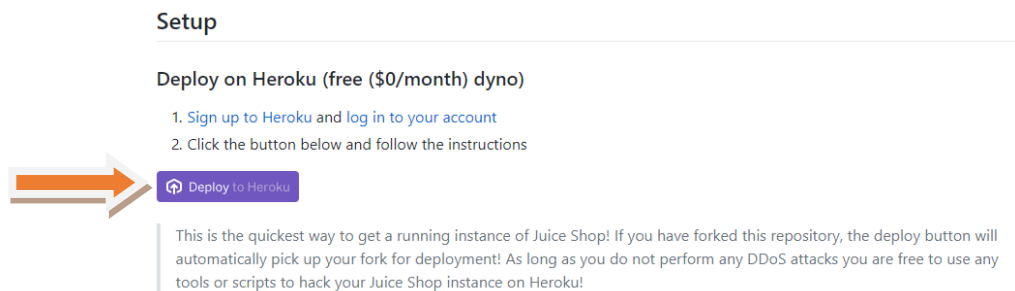


Setting Up The CTF Labs

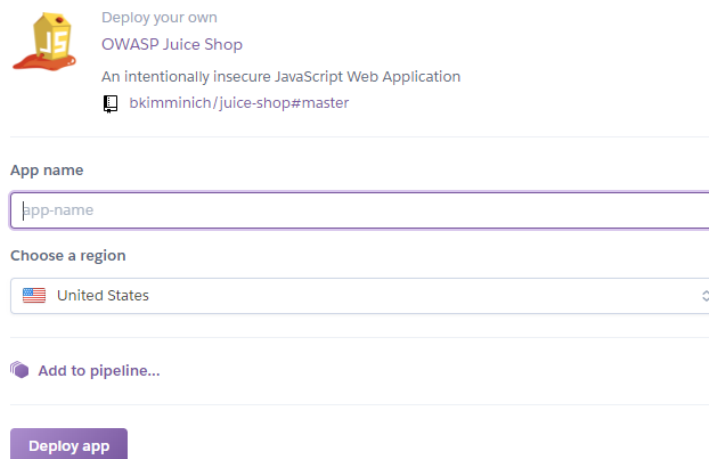
First set up a Heroku account if you don't have one at <https://signup.heroku.com/> ... it's free!



Then open a new tab in your browser and go to <https://github.com/bkimminich/juice-shop> and scroll down to Setup. Click the button and an instance of Juice Shop will be created in your Heroku account!



Name the instance something unique, maybe using your name or handle, then click Deploy App. This takes a few minutes at best, so go have a cup of coffee. We'll be here when you get back.

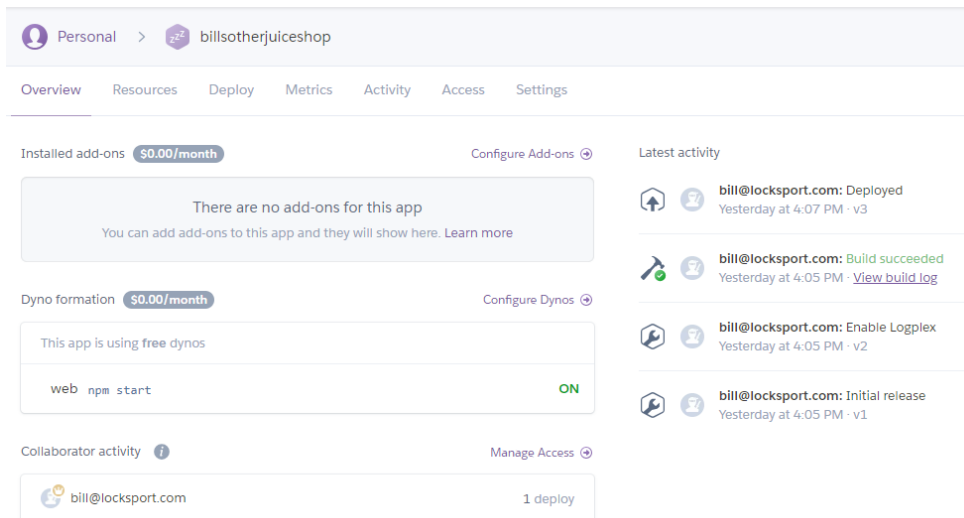


You are done! Now flip the page over and add the CTF configuration.

Setting Up The CTF Labs 2

Next you need to configure the Heroku instance to run in CTF mode.

Go to <https://dashboard.heroku.com> and click on the site you just added.



Click on the Settings tab (far right) then click on the Reveal Config Vars button.

In Config Vars, add a key of `NODE_ENV` and a value of `ctf`, then click Add.
